NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo, State of California, will receive sealed bids for the construction contracts titled

Bids shall be received in accordance with the Contract Documents. The bid package(s) containing all Contract Documents may be downloaded from the Department of Public Works' website at <http://publicworks.smcgov.org/projects-out-bid> (includes complete bid packages) after the mandatory pre-bid conference.

Bids shall be submitted using forms furnished in the Project Manual(s) and in accordance with Instructions to Bidders, and shall be accompanied by a Certified or Cashier's Check or Bid Bond for **\$25,000**. Only one bid per contractor shall be submitted for all contracts.

County intends to award two (2) Job Order Contracts for Electrical/Lighting Contracting Services, JOC-2115 and JOC-2116. One (1) contract will be awarded to the successful lowest bidder and one (1) to the second lowest bidder. Only one bid per Contractor shall be submitted for both contracts.

Bids shall be sealed and filed with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors of the County of San Mateo at the Hall of Justice and Records, 400 County Center, (formerly 401 Marshall Street) 1st Floor, Redwood City, California, on or before **December 3rd, 2020, at 2:30 PM** and will be opened in public in front of Hall of Justice and Records, Redwood City, California due to COVID-19 restrictions or at another location as designated by the County.

There is no Minimum Contract Value for each Job Order Contract. The Maximum Contract Value for each Job Order Contract is up to \$2,000,000. The Contractors will not be issued Job Orders which in total exceed the Maximum Contract Value.
